

VRC members' arrangements at the MCG for the 2023/24 Cricket Season

In accordance with the reciprocal arrangements between the Melbourne Cricket Club and the Victoria Racing Club, the following access arrangements will apply for current financial VRC members for the 2023/24 cricket season.

Boxing Day Test match, One-Day International (ODI) & WBBL/BBL matches

- Current financial VRC members may purchase one visitor ticket for themselves and up to a further two for guests for days 4 and 5 (Dec 29 and 30) of the Boxing Day Test match between Australia and Pakistan, the ODI between Australia and West Indies and all WBBL/BBL matches, which will give access to reserved or unreserved seating on levels 1 and 4 in the MCC Members' Reserve.
- VRC members and their guests will be able utilise all bar and dining facilities and catering outlets in the Reserve with the exception of the Long Room, Jim Stynes Grill and Members' Dining Room on level 2.
- VRC members may purchase visitor tickets through Ticketek or from the ticket windows located on the right-hand side of Gate 2 on match days upon production of their valid VRC membership card. Please note that another form of identification may also need to be produced.

Domestic matches (Sheffield Shield)

- Current financial VRC members may purchase one visitor ticket for themselves and up to a further two for guests for all interstate matches at the MCG, which will give access to unreserved seating on all levels of the MCC Members' Reserve.
- VRC members and their guests will be able utilise all bar and dining facilities and catering outlets in the Reserve including the Long Room, subject to appropriate dress standards being met, i.e., jacket and tie for gentlemen and equivalent standard for women.
- VRC members may only purchase visitor tickets and obtain Long Room passes from the membership services ticket windows at Gate 2 on interstate match days upon production of their valid VRC membership card. Please note that another form of identification may also need to be produced.

General Information

- Access to the Members' Reserve is via Gate 2, which is near the corner of Jolimont Street and Jolimont Terrace.
